OUR MISSION

St. Ephrem Catholic Academy Summer Camp welcomes ALL children from our community ages 4-12 to participate in a Summer Camp filled with fun activities, crafts and sports; while learning responsibility, collegiality and leadership qualities in a friendly, safe environment.

OUR 11TH SEASON!

After 10 successful seasons, we are excited for another summer at St. Ephrem. This year, camp will begin on Monday, July 5, 2021 and end on Thursday, July 29, 2021.

Camp hours are from 9:00AM to 3:00PM. Early drop off as well as aftercare is available if needed for an additional rate of \$25 a day or \$15 per session, per camper.

Our camp counselors will give personal attention to all of our campers. Each camp counselor is required to attend a training session with our camp directors.

COVID-19 PROTOCOL

Due to COVID-19, all staff, as well as campers, are required to have their temperature checked daily and wear a face mask at all times. Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the building as well. All areas will be periodically disinfected throughout the day. We also ask that you notify us if the camper has been in contact with someone who has had Covid. A negative test result is required in order to return to camp. Each camper's belongings will be kept separate from other campers. We will also be separated by age group (please see below). The campers will be in the same group for all 4 weeks. Each group will have snack, lunch and activities separate from other groups.

Activities and Trips this summer!

We will be offering different activities such as arts and crafts, park visits in small groups weather permitting (we go to McKinley Park across the street from St. Ephrem Church on Fort Hamilton), sports, technology, walking trips and in-house trips throughout the summer. These activities are still currently in the planning stages. More information will follow as it becomes known. We will also offer tennis for an additional rate.

SNACKS & LUNCH

One individually wrapped snack and one water bottle will be provided for the campers every day. We will also be selling individually wrapped snacks/drinks during this time. Prices range between \$1 and \$2. Lunch should be brought daily by each camper as well as any extra beverage they may need. Campers' names should be placed on all their belongings. A lunch plan will be offered which includes bagels, pizza and chicken tenders/burgers. Prices will be available prior to camp beginning and need to be paid in full. Ices will be sold three times a week to campers from \$1.00 - \$2.00 daily after lunch. Please note, our camp is **NUT-FREE**, therefore, the children cannot eat anything that has any sort of nut product due to campers with allergies.

Rates

Registration fee is \$100.00 per child due at the time of registration. Registration includes a reusable tote, 2 t-shirts, 1 mask. Campers are required to wear a camp T-shirt as well as mask every day. Additional shirts can be purchased at \$10.00. All payments must be in the form of check, money order or venom. Cash can be sent in for snacks and ices.

We are required to have an updated medical form prior to the first day of camp. Children must be up to date with their inoculations in order to attend, no exceptions. We cannot allow your child to begin without this form.

4 Days: \$300.00 per child, \$200.00 each additional child and 2 Days: \$150.00 per child, \$100.00 each additional child. If you choose to do only two days, it must be the same two days each week and we will need to know which days prior to beginning. Daily rates will not be available.

Our youngest campers will be students entering Pre-Kindergarten in September 2021, and our oldest campers will be students entering grade 6 in September 2021. The children will be grouped as follows: grades Pre-K – 1, Grades 1-3 and Grades 4-6.
